An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted 44 sessions educating 910 individuals on COVID-19, HIV Awareness, and cleanliness
- 2. Planted **1,800 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 2,500 children (1,500 boys and 1,000 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **7,000 individuals** against COVID-19
- 5. Registered **1,926 CNICs, 500 B-forms, 100 Nikkah Namas,** and **20 death certificates** in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated 4,800 animals with the help of the Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **1,800 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of the Government Health Department

Women leaders of **LSO Qadam** are planning and implementing development activities both on a self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS program is empowering rural women in Sindh by realizing the power they gain from collective action. The organized women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable, and are also taking self-initiative to improve their lives.

Combating the Socio-economic Bearings of the COVID-19

The COVID-19 Pandemic affected poor households of the Union Council (UC) Bahman badly. Due to the pandemic-imposed lockdown, multiple wage earners of the households were left without labour work. With no source of income, soon these families became food insecure. Observing the deteriorating circumstances, the leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) formed a committee to work on this matter by seeking the help of the UC Chairman. As a result, the designated committee approached and explained all the circumstances to the UC chairman. The UC Chairman in response generously provided food ration packs to 110 deserving households of the UC, which helped them in overcoming starvation during the pandemic.
