An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **64 sessions** educating **1,850 individuals** on COVID-19, Family Planning and cleanliness
- 2. Planted **5,000 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 5,000 children (4,000 boys and 1,000 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **7,000 individuals** against COVID-19
- 5. Registered **600 CNICs**, **500 B-forms**, **250 Nikkah Namas**, and **10 death certificates** in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated 1,800 animals with the help of the Livestock Department
- 7. Provided stipend worth **PKR 12,000** to **300 households** by the help of Benazir Income Support EHSAAS Programme

Women leaders of **LSO Umeed** are planning and implementing development activities both on a self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS program is empowering rural women in Sindh by realizing the power they gain from collective action. The organized women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable, and are also taking self-initiative to improve their lives.

Serving the Poor households

The fear following COVID-19 Pandemic in the Union Council (UC) Karani resulted in strict lockdown aiming to warrant social distancing among the individuals. However, this restriction in mobility resulted in multiple daily wagers losing their work. Having a poor socioeconomic background and minimal savings, the poor households were unable to meet their nutritional needs, which resulted in hardship and distress. To help the poor families' leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) Umeed held a meeting with the UC chairman. Whereas, after surveying the crises situation and identifying 150 households in need for support, the UC Chairman provided food rations packs to them. This assistance in the time of suffering reduced the risk of starvation among many individuals in the UC Karani.
