An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **927 awareness sessions** educating **23,175 individuals** on family planning, health and sanitation, education, MR vaccination, and COVID-19 vaccination.
- 2. Planted **4,850 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 1,188 children (475 boys and 713 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **12,800 individuals** against COVID-19
- 5. Registered **5,655 CNICs, 790 B-forms, 1,790 Nikkah Namas,** and **188 death certificates** in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **1,800 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **225 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department

Women leaders of the **LSO Bachal Gugo** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

Fixing Water Connections

The dwellers of village Khuda Dino Mangsi were facing an issue of water leakage in their area. The damaged water pipes passing through the village graveyard would leak making the ground slippery and increasing the risk of falling. To solve this issue, leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) Bachal Gugo arranged a meeting with a Member of the Provincial Assembly (MPA) of the Pakistan People's Party (PPP) and explained the existing situation to him. In response, the MPA decided to help them by providing funds for the reinstallation of water pipes. After the funds were dispatched to the LSO leaders, new pipes were bought and fitted. The restoration of pipes brought cleanliness to the village graveyard, where community individuals can now stop over without any trouble.
