#### What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

# Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **3,795 awareness sessions** educating **94,875 individuals** on various aspects like health and hygiene, mother & child health, prevention of COVID-19
- 2. Planted **3,200 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 1,980 children (1,235 boys and 745 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **8,093 individuals** against COVID19
- Registered 785 CNICs, 8,700 B-forms, 5,430 Nikkah Namas, and 96 death certificates in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **1,000 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **1,500 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department

Women leaders of the **LSO Begna** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are also taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

#### **Reducing the Impact of Pandemic COVID-19**

The COVID-19 Pandemic led to fright among the community members of the Union Council (UC) Begna. It peaked when the government imposed lockdown and the dwellers could not find labour work. Worried about the loss of income, the community individuals came together and requested leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) for assistance during the pandemic. As a result, the LSO leaders sent an application to the nongovernment organization (NGO) SAWFCO officials for facilitation in this matter. The NGO officials responded positively and provided the LSO leaders with food ration bags and hygiene kits, consisting of facemasks, hand sanitisers and soaps, to the community households. Due to this aid, the community members were able to live through the pandemic's harsh times.
