#### What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

## Activities implemented through the EU funded SUCCESS Programme

# Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **2,440 awareness sessions** educating individuals on family planning, health and sanitation, education, MR vaccination, and COVID-19 vaccination.
- 2. Planted 3,838 trees in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 2,623 children (1,800 boys and 823 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **1,643 individuals** against COVID-19
- Registered 6,430 CNICs, 198 B-forms, 1,014 Nikkah Namas, and 354 death certificates in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **2,461 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **512 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department

Women leaders of the **LSO Googani** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

### **Expanding the Infrastructure in the UC Goongani**

Due to the poor road quality, farmers of the Union Council (UC) Goongani were unable to bring agricultural vehicles, like tractors to their farms. Therefore, they depended upon the traditional farming methods of ploughing animals, which would consume much of their efforts and time. Leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) decided to ease their troubles through the construction of a road in their UC making mobility accessible. To undertake this plan, the LSO leaders contacted a Member of the National Assembly (MNA) of the Pakistan People's Party (PPP) for help. The MNA kindly agreed and mandated the construction of a road in the UC. However, the road is under construction now and the farmers and dwellers hope it will result in the improvement and development of the UC.
