An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

LSO Initiatives

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted 13,000 awareness sessions educating 325,000 individuals on basic rights, women empowerment family planning, health and sanitation, education, MR vaccination, Covid-19 vaccination.
- Planted 3,500 trees in different villages of the UC 2.
- Enrolled 3,345 children (1,772 boys and 1,573 girls) in school 3.
- Facilitated the vaccination of 10,000 individuals against COVID-19 4.
- Registered 14,000 CNICs, 2,951 B-forms, 1,200 Nikkah Namas, and 1,600 death certificates in the 5. Union Council
- Vaccinated 2,500 animals with the help of Livestock Department 6.
- Treated **450 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department 7.

Women leaders of the LSO Laigpur are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are also taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

Tree Plantation

Realising the usefulness of tree plantations for both human beings and animals, in terms of providing shade, reducing heat on hot days of summer, and enhancing the quality of air, leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) decided to run a plantation drive in different villages of the Union Council (UC) Laiqpur. Due to the vigorous efforts and mobilisation of the LSO leaders and other community members, 3,500 trees have been planted in different villages across the UC. This initiative has helped



the broader community to understand the significance of tree plantations and convinced them to take this initiative in future as well.
