An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **1,840 awareness sessions** educating **46,000 individuals** on family planning, health and sanitation, education, MR vaccination, Covid-19 vaccination.
- 2. Planted 5,341 trees in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 3,250 children (1,754 boys and 1,168 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of 1,7300 individuals against COVID-19
- 5. Registered 6,454 CNICs, 203 B-forms, 845 Nikkah Namas, and 72 death certificates in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **788 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **232 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department

Women leaders of the **LSO Mureed Khoso** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are also taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

CNIC Registration

Leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) Mureed Khoso District Sujawal have covered all their strategic plans in a significant way. They are determined to make those plans sustainable and exclusive for the long term. One of the major contributions of the LSO to the community is to ensure the eligible individuals get the identity of being citizens of the state. For this cause, the LSO Leaders connected with the Local Government and requested to facilitate the local residents of the Union Council (UC) in getting their Computerized National Identity Cards (CNICs). Government officials approved their request and provided transportation to the desired residents to reach the NADRA office. Through this initiative, a larger number of people have registered their CNICs.
