#### What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

## Activities implemented through the EU funded SUCCESS Programme

# Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **52 sessions** educating **3,251 individuals** on various health and educational topics
- 2. Planted **4,100 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled **1,300 children** (700 boys and 600 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **3,412 individuals** against COVID-19
- 5. Registered **750 CNICs, 260 B-forms, 50 Nikkah Namas, 95 death certificates** and **260 Votes** in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **2,375 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **2,534 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department
- 8. Facilitated **1,280 women** in the health centres for safe deliveries

Women leaders of the **LSO Insaf** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are also taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

### **Education for Girls**

Girls in the Local Support Organisation (LSO) Insaf were unable to continue their studies due to the unavailability of a favourable enabling environment at schools. The LSO leaders took this issue seriously, arranged a meeting with the Deputy Commissioner (DC) and raised the concern of increasing illiteracy and improper school facilities for girls in their villages. The Deputy Commissioner took notice of the issue and initiated the renovation of the primary school building immediately. Upon their request, two extra classrooms and two washrooms were also constructed. Moreover, the provision of primary middle school for girls was also approved to promote literacy in the LSO. The initiative provided an opportunity for girls to continue their education.
