An update on the work of Local Support Organisations



What are LSO?

LSOs or Local Support Organisations are a Union Council level federation of Community Institutions. In a bid to reduce poverty at the household level and empower marginalised people (esp. women), they carry out community-led development and develop linkages with government and non-government organisations.

Activities implemented through self-help and in collaboration with Government and other development agencies:

- 1. Conducted **60 sessions** educating **2,986 individuals** on various health and educational topics
- 2. Planted **850 trees** in different villages of the UC
- 3. Enrolled 5,620 children (3,490 boys and 2,130 girls) in school
- 4. Facilitated the vaccination of **2,513 individuals** against COVID-19
- 5. Registered 1,050 CNICs,130 B-forms, 50 Nikkah Namas 490 death certificates and 5,000 Votes in the Union Council
- 6. Vaccinated **8,930 animals** with the help of Livestock Department
- 7. Treated **2,859 patients** for free through a medical health camp with the help of Government Health Department
- 8. Facilitated **1,432 women** in the health centres for safe deliveries

Women leaders of the **LSO Mehran** are planning and implementing development activities both on self-help basis as well as in collaboration with government agencies. The EU-funded SUCCESS programme is empowering rural women in Sindh by realising the power they gain from collective action. The organised women are gaining awareness about their rights, making the service providers accountable and are also taking self-initiatives to improve their lives.

Enabling Access to Maternity Homes

Due to the tradition of handling birth deliveries by the untrained daaes, there was no practice of regular check-ups and getting the service of qualified medical staff for deliveries in the Union Councils (UC). This aggravated the health of mothers and babies and even resulted in deaths in extreme cases. Leaders of the Local Support Organisation (LSO) Mehran realised the seriousness of this issue and decided to conduct health sessions especially focusing on maternal and child healthcare. Along with the awareness sessions, the LSO president accompanied pregnant women to the nearby health care centers/maternity homes and supported them in their safe deliveries.
