

Flood Damages and Relief Update

August 25, 2022









The recent monsoon rains have affected different parts of the country. According to NDMA, over 3.1 million people are affected in 116 districts across Pakistan. Moreover, other than over 900 deaths; damages to roads, bridges, shops, crops, livestock, schools, health facilities and houses have been reported. Over 500,000 houses have been damaged (either fully or partially). The Ministry of Climate Change and NDMA have warned about more rains during August 2022 and onwards.

» Assessment of Damages by NRSP

Upon request of the local government authorities, NRSP is conducting need assessments through the help of community institutions across the country where it is present, in order to respond to the needs of the communities adversely affected by the floods. The initial review of these assessments reported that the heavy rains and floods have badly affected 422,000 households in 416 union councils of 16 districts across the Country.

» Summary of relief work done by NRSP

NRSP, having nationwide presence, has presence in all severely flood affected areas with a network of grass roots level Community Organizations and a cadre of trained professionals and community activists. Like previously in Earthquake 2005, Floods 2010; NRSP responded to the Floods 2022 and started emergency rescue operations in worst hit areas. NRSP has started its relief operations in 6 districts of Pakistan including DGK, Rajanpur, Matiari, Tando Allah Yar and Badin with the financial support of PPAF and NRSP's own funds.

Warehouse facilities of NRSP

NRSP has a chain of warehouses that are/have been used for emergency relief operations. The largest such warehouse is in Sehala (Rawalpindi, Punjab) with a capacity of 200,000 cft storage space. Others are in Bahawalpur (Punjab), Aza Khel (KP), Turbat (Baluchistan) and Hydrabad (Sindh). With a unique network of stockpiling facility, NRSP has the capacity to respond to the emergencies in any part of Pakistan. An appropriate inventory management system and trained warehouse managers are on board to control the in and out flow of the relief goods.
